ISAAC TAYLOR, SR.

Isaac Taylor, Sr. was born in 1811 in Indian Creek, DeKalb County, Tennessee. He was married twice. In 1830 when he was nineteen he married eighteen year old Mary Lawrence. They had four children: William, Nancy, Susanna, and Lucretia. Mary died ten years later in 1840 when she was twenty-eight years old.

After Mary's death, Isaac married a lady named Ruth, last name unknown. They too had a family of four, two sons and two daughters: Mary, James, Thomas and Ruth.

About 1857 Isaac and his youngest brother, Lewis Taylor, moved to Marion County, Arkansas. They are both listed on the 1860 Buffalo City, Marion County census. By 1863 they had followed their older brother, Joshua Taylor, to Pope County, Illinois. It is not known at this time how many of the family went. We do know from the 1870 Marion County census that Isaac's son James Taylor stayed behind. It appeared he either lived in Yellville, Arkansas, or very close to that town.

I do not know when either Isaac or Ruth died, but at the present time we have not found any further records concerning them.

Isaac and Mary's daughter, Nancy Paralee Taylor married John Johnson in Marion County, Arkansas. They moved to Pope County, Illinois, around 1861. On December 27, 1863, her husband, John Johnson, joined the 13th Regiment of Illinois Cavalry Volunteers for action in the Civil War. John died of disease on July 27, 1864. (From Gerald Lewis)

you don't know me, I'm from the Taylor family. I have read your book & you have been told some things that needs to be corrected.

Let me explain where I come in the Taylors. My mother was the daughter of Benjamin Harrison & he was the son of Henry Harrison Taylor.

You have the children of Henry Harrison Taylor belonging to the wrong woman. His first children were by Anne Waldon & their children were: Benjamin Harrison - John William (Bill & Caroline).

The other children were by Angeline Self & they were - Robert Caswell - Amanda - Melinda (Lyn) Martell.

Now the Spence woman we know nothing about. I have asked the children of Amanda (aunt where Henry Harrison lived for years) they never heard of her & to my mother never heard of her. There were 5 girls born to Benjamin Harrison while they lived in Tenn. & none of these girls knew any thing about Henry marrying her. & I have been with Henry Harrison (my great granddad) a lot because he visited us quite often & I've never heard her name called.

I have traced back in your book & I come from William Taylor Sr.

Benjamin Harrison had 12 children, my mother was the oldest. I have all their names, births, & who they married. Grandpa Harrison had 60 grand children & I'm the oldest grand child (I'm 80 yrs old now) you see Henry Harrison came to Tex. in 1880 & lived on Mr. Cameron farm just west of McR. & my grandpa came to Tex. in 1889. He went to Mr. Camerons farm but the next year he moved to Doc Abbotts

place & stayed a few years then moved his family to a farm in the Higgins Community where all his children grew up & married. He lived there a few years after Grandma Elizabeth died then moved to Oklahoma & worked in an oil fields home until he got to old. He died here in McK. at Mary Odell's house (his 3rd girl).

He was 99 yrs & 9 months when he passed away.

I have Henry Harrison & Annie Walden's marriage certificate. DeKalb Co. Tenn. I've been getting all

I could on the Taylors here & around McK. & Joe Taylor (John Taylor's grandson) has a lot I don't have he & his wife have searched every where they knew to go to find out more than we all knew. He has the Taylor Crest & he said he would make a picture of it & give me one.

We have a Taylor reunion here on the first Sunday in June at Finch Park just behind me here.

The picture on page 154 of Thomas Taylor looks exactly like my granddad Benjamin Harrison & Pleasant Taylor looks like my uncle Jerry Benjamin Taylor (He is on the other page to the left) Elijah Taylor resembles Henry Harrison Taylor.

Most of Henry Harrison's children live in Texas & I see them pretty often. Because we had a Taylor reunion for years but now they have it in places I can't go any more so the younger ones live around McK. is starting a new reunion. So come down if & when you can. You can get a lot more about Henry Harrison.

BENJAMIN T. TAYLOR

Before his death in the late 1840's Benjamin T. Taylor was quite active in the affairs of Indian Creek. He is found in many of the DeKalb court records which involved land transfers, being a witness for legal documents and transactions of that nature.

Since the Trail book we have received quite a bit of information concerning his son Henry Harrison Taylor who was sometimes known as Tinker Taylor. I still have not found out why he was called Tinker but I do use the name in order to remember which Henry Taylor he was. I am enclosing a letter I received from a lady in Texas a number of years ago taking me to task for not having my facts straight. It has taken me quite some time to figure out why we had conflicting information concerning the wives of Tinker Taylor. However someone was finally considerate enough to photocopy the marriage records in DeKalb County and it appears that someone had inadvertently spelled Self as Spencer. I had received information that Henry H. Taylor had married Mary T. Spencer on May 1, 1872. From some of his descendants I was given the information that he had married Angeline Self but no date.

The original marriage record stated that Henry H. Taylor married Mary A. Self on May 1, 1872. I'm still not certain how Self could be mistaken for Spencer but I do know that I have encountered numerous errors on lists that people copy, publish, and sell. Many times when you search out the original it does differ. It is easy to see how the Mary and Angeline names could be confused since she was apparently Mary Angeline Self and they were married on May 1, 1872. My apologies to everyone who was upset by the mistake.

Additions and corrections for the family tree of John B. Taylor, found on pages 79 through 84 of On the Taylor Trail. John B. Taylor is usually referred to as Bully John.

JOHN B. (Bully John) TAYLOR

Bully John Taylor was one of the younger sons of Joseph and Creasy Taylor. He was born in 1820 in the Indian Creek area and spent his entire life there. He was married twice, first to Drucilla Turner and second to Nancy Drury. Bully John and Drucilla had ten children, six sons and four daughters.

I have received additional information on one of his sons, Wilson Taylor, who was born in 1847. The story of Wilse is an interesting one. As a teenager he lied about his age in order to enlist in the Union Army during the Civil War.

Many of his relatives, friends, and neighbors, including some of his brothers, were for the Confederacy. Wilse's loyalty to the Union did not endear him to certain segments in the south. On the Taylor Trail related some of the stories we have heard about Wilse Taylor. Since that time I have heard and received more, some of which I would like to relate here.

The following story was from Roy Taylor, one of his grandsons who still lives in the area of Illinois where Wilse lived. It concerned the enlistment of Wilse in the Union Army when he was still a fairly young teenager.

"My grandpa Wilse and his brother got in an argument while cutting wood one day. One went north and one went south. After the war the rebels ran Wilse out of Tennessee and he came north to Golconda, Illinois, where he had a

sister living. The family later followed in a covered wagon that was pulled by a blind horse and a mule that couldn't see. He lived in Golconda several years and then settled on a farm two or three miles east of Ewing, Illinois. Later he moved to Whittington, Illinois."

Both towns are in Franklin County, which is less than thirty-five miles from the huge Taylor settlement in Hamilton and White Counties of Illinois.

Wilse's wife, Elizabeth, was also for the Union and this story was told about her. One day a rebel came to her door to get her brother. She shot the rebel with her shotgun, but apparently did not kill him, he turned and ran, jumping over the rock fence that surrounded her house.

And then there is this story about Elizabeth with two different endings. A group of Confederate soldiers came to her door and wanted horses. She told them they could take what they wanted but to leave the stud, this was her horse and the one she rode. They decided they wanted him too so while they were eating she asked if she could go out to see him one last time. As she left the house she picked up a butcher knife. When she got to the barn she slashed the horse's throat causing him to die. The other ending, told by another descendant said that after the soldiers had left she ran across the field to get help and between them they saved the horse.

We also heard this version of Wilse's decision to move to Illinois. Dred Fish was Elizabeth's father. He too was for the Union. One day after the war when he was coming home from the hay field the 'Night Riders', with handkerchiefs over their faces, rode up behind the wagon and shot Dred Fish in the back. The Confederates then warned Wilse to get out or he too would be killed. He later had to hide in the trees behind his house when the 'Night Riders' came and burned his barn down. He stayed in the trees for a month, his wife bringing his food out to him, until he decided to head for his sister Sarah's place in Illinois.

The Civil War service records stated that Wilse was a private in Company C, 5th Regiment of Tennessee Cavalry. He volunteered on November 18, 1863, for three years, was discharged on August 14, 1865, at Puluski, Tennessee. He was five feet, five inches tall, had fair complexion, blue eyes, and light hair. He was a farmer. He listed his birthdate as June 2, 1844, and his age as eighteen although in reality he was born in 1847 which made him only about fifteen years old when he enlisted. When we asked one of his grandsons to tell us more about Wilse his only response was "He was kind of hot tempered."

Wilse and his wife are buried in Liberty Cemetery which is located in Northern Township, Franklin County, Illinois. This is not far from Macedonia. Several of their children and grandchildren are also buried in this cemetery which we visited in 1988.

One of his descendants, Roy Taylor, who is now retired and living in Macedonia, Illinois, is married to a very

talented quilt maker. Another descendant, Fred Williams, who lives in Evansville, Indiana, is a very artistic and interesting individual. Marjorie Robinson, Neal Taylor, and I visited Fred in his home in 1988. He has glaucoma and was very nearly blind at the time of our visit. Yet he was caring for a barn full of pygmy goats, a large assortment of fancy pigeons, plus a variety of other animals. His home was beautifully decorated, much of it by his own hand. He had both sculpted and painted many of the house's accessories. However since he was going blind he had been forced to give up these pursuits. In their place he had started carving in wood. The pieces he was working on were beautiful - intricately detailed figures of animals. He did his carving in a loft he had made in his garage.

Fred had also raised his four children by himself, he and his wife having been divorced when the children were young. His oldest son, Mark Williams, became a model and did some television advertising. He eventually went into television script writing and producing. He wrote for "The Cosby Show", resigning in 1988 to write and become the executive producer of the television show called "Roseanne". Professionally he is known as Matt Williams. He is also executive producer of "The Carol Burnett Show". At the present time he is in the process of developing a new television show called "Home Improvement" in which he will again serve as executive producer. Six segments of the sitcom are to be aired sometime during the 1991 - 1992 season with Tim Allen as its star.

Mark Williams, a 1973 graduate of the University of Indiana, was given the Hoosier Award, Indiana's highest award for his work on the "Cosby Show". It was presented to Mark by Indiana Representative Sam Turpin during Marks's visit to the Indiana Children's Christain Home in Ladoga.

According to "Time" magazine, the setting for the Roseanne show, a small city in Indiana, is fashioned after Mark's hometown of Evansville, Indiana.

I have received many conflicting birth and death dates on the various children of Wilse and Elizabeth Fish Taylor. Most of the dates listed here have been taken from tombstones whenever it has been possible to find them.

LEWIS TAYLOR

Lewis Taylor was the youngest son of Joseph Taylor. He was born in 1824 in Indian Creek, DeKalb County, Tennessee. He was only about six years old when his father died.

About 1846, when he was twenty-two years old, he married a woman named Visa, last name unknown. She too was born in 1824 in Tennessee. They had a daughter born in 1847 who they named Lucinda. Lewis and Visa are found on the 1850 census of DeKalb County, Tennessee.

I am of the opinion that this marriage ended in divorce for Lewis and Visa although I have not found any record of it happening. There are three reasons for my belief that this may have happened. One is the six year age difference in his two oldest children, which for that day and age was more than somewhat unusual.

The second is that I have found a record in DeKalb County of a Visa Taylor marrying Mathew Johnson on May 11, 1854. The third reason is that on the 1860 Marion County, Arkansas, census, Lewis' wife name is given as Nicy and that she was born in 1828, making her four years younger than Visa. However on his estate settlement, it gives his wife's name as Vicy. But since I have not seen any of the original papers, nor found her on any later census records I really wonder about the Vicy, much of the early day script was extremely fancy and it is often hard to figure out what some of the capital letters were. Many V's and N's were written very much alike.

This leads me to the belief that Lewis and Visa were divorced about 1850 and he remarried in 1852 to a woman named Nicy. From the 1860 Marion County, Arkansas, census it indicates that Lewis and Nicy had least three children; Lucretia, born in 1853; William, in 1856; and Joseph born in 1857. This was the last census record that we have found concerning his family and to date we have not heard from any of his descendants.

Lewis stayed in Tennessee until 1856 or 1857 when he moved to Marion County, Arkansas. Marion County borders Searcy County on the south. Many Taylors moved to Searcy County, Arkansas, during the 1850's also. The area where the two groups settled was less than thirty miles apart. Lewis and his family are found living near Buffalo City on the 1860 Marion County census. He did not stay long in Arkansas. The present day members of some of the other families that moved to Searcy County do not know of any other related Taylors in the area.

In 1863 Lewis bought one hundred twenty acres of land in Pope County, Illinois. His brother, Joshua, co-signed his promissory note for payment of the land. Lewis died on June 1, 1864 in Pope County at the age of forty. The estate settlement mentions Vicy Taylor, Joshua Taylor and W. S. Vinegard. His children were still minors at the time of his death; ranging in age from fourteen years to seven years. They were not listed by name.

Joshua Taylor bought Lewis's land in 1866 from the estate.

MARTHA TAYLOR TERRELL

The following contains the additions and corrections for Chapter 4, pages 24 through 27 of On the Taylor Trail.

We have learned nothing new concerning Martha Taylor Terrell, but we have added some more to her family tree. We have also had the privilege of meeting some of her descendants who still live in Georgia. I also received an Elbert County newspaper article from Neal Taylor concerning one of Martha's granddaughters that I'm including. The article was taken from the June 27, 1980, "Elberton Star".

Robert W. Terrell was Martha Taylor and William Terrell's third child, born in 1804. He died when he was only forty-five years old in 1849. He married Sarah Wanslow or Wansley. Larkin Wansley, age seventy-five, and who I assume was her father, was living with the family in 1860 according to the Elbert County census.

Sarah Wansley (earlier spelling was Wanslow) died in 1883. She left a will which divided all of her property four ways, each of her four surviving children were to receive a fourth. For some unexplained reason her daughter, Lucy Ann Manerva's share was to be held in trust. The will is on file in Elbert County, Georgia.

Robert and Sarah had seven children, the eldest being Lucy Ann Manerva Terrell. Some remember her being called Nervie. The above mentioned article concerning Lucy Terrell has a tendency to stray just a bit from the truth as is evidenced by the following 1860 census record from Elbert County:

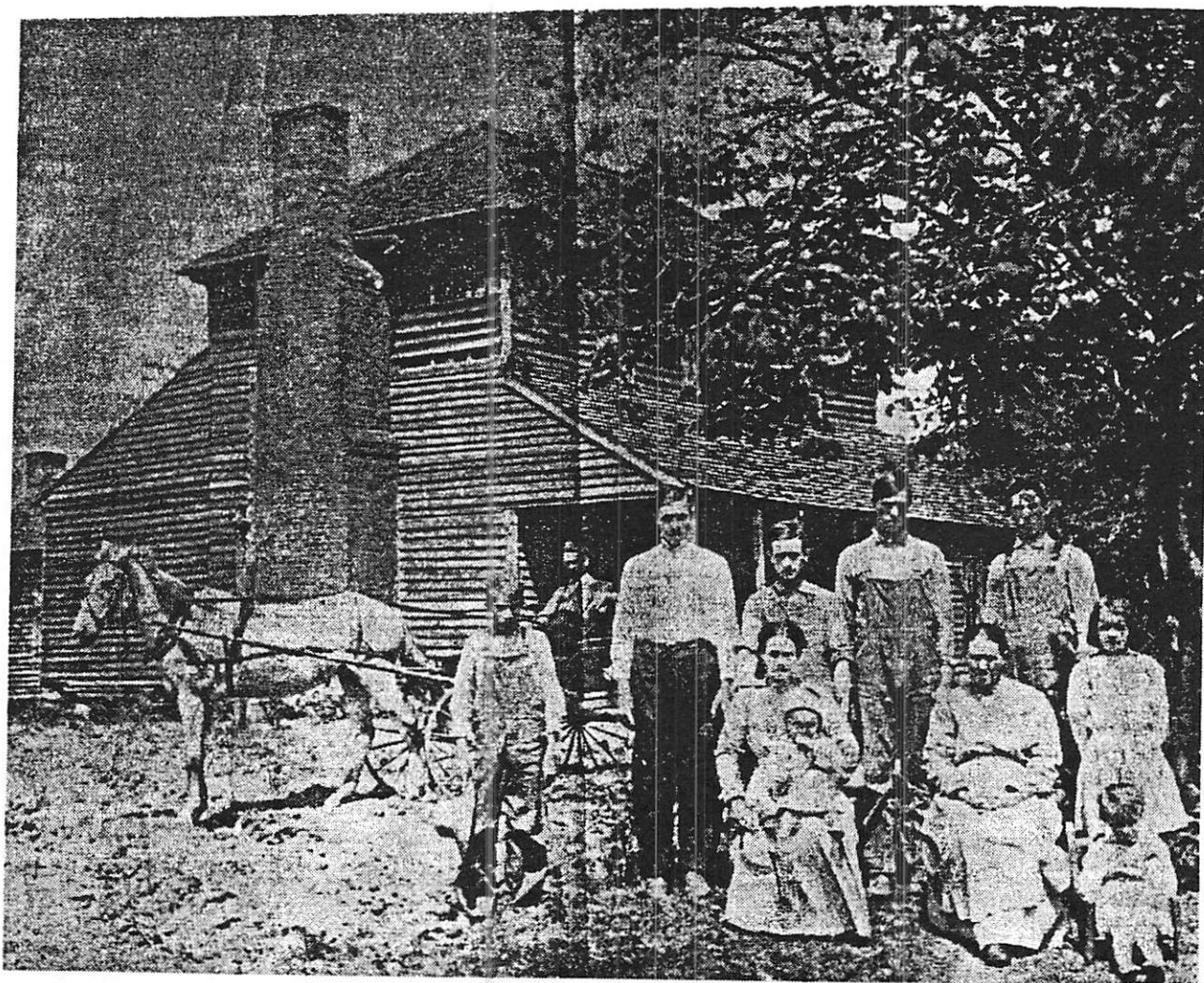

The old Stratton homeplace, with its two hundred fifty acres of land, less than a mile from the Savannah River near Gregg Shoals, must have stood there many, many years before it was finally torn down. It was a unique and interesting home that had housed generations of Strattons in its day.

Actually the Stratton house, once so full of life and laughter, belongs to history now. The only part that's still standing is in Elberton in Mrs. Josephine Oglesby's yard. When the old place was sold by the Stratton family, Mrs. Oglesby's father, Mr. Frank Fortson, bought it. She kept the little log cabin that had been the kitchen. It was separated from the rest of the house as were many of the kitchens in the early American homes.

I can appreciate the Fortson's and Oglesby's interest in and love for that old place. I'm glad she kept that little log cabin. If there is such a thing as the spirit of a family remaining on the premises of the homeplace where they had dwelt so long, the spirit of the old Stratton homeplace has to be one of charity, adventure, and nobility. One would have to feel so secure in a place that had been filled with and surrounded by such peace and tranquility as it had been.

I remember the Stratton home. I remember it well. I

remember that kitchen which was built apart from the rest of the house. You can't see it on the picture above. I remember that "shed" room at the end of the front porch. I know which Stratton added it onto the house. I know what was in it years after this picture was made. Leonora's dolls, doll carriages, doll beds and everything a doll needed was in there. Leonora Stratton wasn't even born when this picture was taken. Neither was I. Her dad wasn't even married then. Neither was mine.

Did you ever try looking backward through the eyes of your mind to see how many generations you can remember? Then you can look forward to see how many you know that are living now. Try it. You might be surprised to know how many generations you can remember — even if it is ever so faintly.

The Stratton home, according to Frank J. Stratton Sr., was the first house in Georgia to have glass window panes. I already knew that too, or at least I had been told that down through the years. That bit of history has been passed from generation to generation.

The house had belonged to some of Peter "Pete" L. Stratton's ancestors, his parents or grandparents, before it belonged to him. Also at some time it had belonged to his aunt who had married a

Norman.

A romantic tale is told about the parents of P.L. Stratton.

His mother was Lucy Minerva Terrell whose parents were wealthy — with a vast expanse of land. It's still called "The Corner" by a few of their descendants. Lucy Minerva first married Robert W. Cleveland I. They had two children called Bob and Bette. Their real names were Robert William Jr. and Elizabeth. When Robert W. Cleveland I died at an early age, Lucy Minerva had many responsibilities and needed help in rearing her two small children. Also she was desperately in need of dependable farm help.

One day a ragged, shaggy and dirty man appeared at her door and asked for a job as a planter. It seems that the dirt didn't hide the two expressive, bright eyes that looked out of that handsome face. So Lucy Minerva trusted him immediately and hired him right on the spot.

His name was L. Peter Stratton. He was from Canada and had been shipwrecked somewhere. He had walked a long, long way. He turned out to be a good, trustworthy man; so Lucy Minerva Terrell Cleveland married the adventurous L. Peter Stratton.

They were the parents of Peter "Pete" L. Stratton; pictured in the buggy above, and

two other sons and two daughters.

I never heard a quotation that came from L.P. Stratton except one. When the Civil War broke out, someone made a remark that the war wouldn't amount the anything — if they started before breakfast, he said, they should beat the North by dinner.

In reply, L.P. Stratton said, "It'll be the longest dinner session you've ever heard of."

I like what L.P. said. He must have had insight.

The Pete Stratton family, pictured in front of their home, moved there in 1904. His mother lived with them the last several years of her life.

Later on, sometime in the thirties, the Pete Stratton family moved to their home in Elberton. That house is still standing on the Hartwell Highway. It is now owned and occupied by Mr. and Mrs. Marvin Davis.

It was while her grandparents lived in Elberton that Leonora Stratton and her parents lived in the old Stratton homeplace. That's when we played with dolls in the shed room — as it was called. That's when we swung in the swings under the huge mulberry trees and the huge oak trees. That's when we first swung in the two double swings built into a wooden frame — on the front porch. I

think about those days and wonder, "could those mulberry trees still be standing there? Were they as massive and tall as they appeared to be then?"

Still later in life, after their sons and daughters were married and gone from home, Mr. and Mrs. Pete Stratton sold their home in Elberton and the hundred thirty-nine acres of land that went with it and moved to their old home and farm near the banks of the Savannah where they lived graciously ever after. The tale of one of the Stratton boys and his wife ends here.
